


## World War II Book Report

Design a new cover for your World War II reading book that you read this quarter. If you read more than one, please pick your favorite book. These will be displayed in the pod as advertisements for other readers.

1. **FRONT COVER:** The design must be one of your own creation and does not use the art or pictures from the book or movie based on the book. You can use clipart to create your cover, but it cannot already be associated with the book. You are redesigning the book's cover.
2. **FRONT COVER:** The title and author's name must be clear and prominent.
3. **INSIDE FRONT FLAP:** Books always have short summaries on the inside flaps, so your cover will include a short SUMMARY on the front inside flap. Font cannot be smaller than 11 font or larger than 14 font and you can pick the font style you like. (Look at books and class examples but do not copy what your book already has and do not give away the ending.)
4. **BACK COVER:** Include a catchy BLURB on the back that encourages someone to pick up the book and read it. It is not just a repeat of the summary on the flap. It has to pump people up to get them to want to read your book. You also need to include: **Created by and your first and last name on the bottom of the back cover.**
5. **BACK COVER:** Include 3 Quotes of recommendation from famous people who have "read" the book. Don't just choose anyone. Choose someone who it makes sense would read the book and have a comment about it. (Clearly you have to pretend here. You will need to figure out what famous person might read the book and what good things they would say about it.)
6. **INSIDE BACK FLAP:** Include two quotes (word for word) from the book. Include the page numbers. If this does not fill the whole column, you can either write a little about who the author is or other books by that author. You are trying to fill the space on the flap with relevant information.
7. **SPINE:** The title of the book, author's name and the color coded library band with the first three letters of the author's last name included.
8. Information must be typed or written very neatly.
9. Covers must be colorful and inviting. You are trying to draw the readers to your book. Fill any blank areas with illustrations that go with the theme of the book.
10. All covers will be the size given in class (no exceptions) 11 X 17

You will have 4 class periods to work on this assignment. Plan accordingly and use your time efficiently.
